

# DAY CAMP INFO SHEET

## Summer 2019



### SCHEDULE

**Days: Monday, June 17 – Friday, June 21**

**Hours: 12:30 pm – 5:00 pm**

Children should be picked up by 5:20 pm at the latest. Please call us as soon as possible if you will be late. A fee of \$1 per minute will be charged for every minute you are later than 5:20 pm. Every attempt will be made to contact parents. If by 6 pm the parents are not reachable and the child has not been picked up, Child Protective Services will be contacted.

### ACTIVITIES

Daily activities will include:

- Opening and closing group discussion time
- Interactive pet social time
- Interactive game time
- Animal related learning activities
- Healthy snack time
- Guest speakers related to animal themes
- Arts and crafts time
- Field Trips (parents/guardians will be informed of any field trips ahead of time)

### NEEDED ITEMS

Campers should dress in clothes that are appropriate for active, sometimes messy activities. For safety reasons, all campers must wear athletic shoes or other shoes with closed toes. Sandals and Crocs are not appropriate for many of our activities. Children wearing these shoes to camp may not be allowed to participate in all activities.

We discourage all participants from bringing anything of value with them to camp. This includes money, toys, video games, etc. Campers may bring cameras, but Great River Rescue is not responsible for any damaged, lost or stolen equipment.

Campers who bring cell phones with them to camp should expect to use their phones only to contact parents in case of an emergency. Calling or texting during camp activities will not be permitted.

### WEATHER STATEMENT

Sunscreen is also strongly recommended because many of our activities take place outdoors. Campers are responsible for bringing and applying their own sunscreen. Summer camp activities will proceed rain or shine; campers should bring appropriate weather gear as needed. (Please label all personal items with your child's name.)

### COST/REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Camp is available for kids entering grades 3 – 5. \$125 fee for the full week of camp. Registration will not be considered complete until payment is received. Includes all activities, materials, daily snack and GRR t-shirt. Accepted payment methods include cash, check, or credit card. Registration deadline is June 1<sup>st</sup>. A waitlist will be created once the camp fills up. Kids may only participate in one week of camp. Refunds for any cancellation of registration will be accepted up to June 1, 2019. After June 1, no refunds will be given.

Happy Tails Summer Day Camp is supervised by GRR staff and volunteer helpers. First Aid and CPR Certified individuals will be on-site. Proceeds from the summer camp will benefit the animals and work of Great River Rescue.
